We work to make sure people with learning difficulties are treated fairly and included.

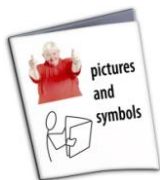
What do we do?

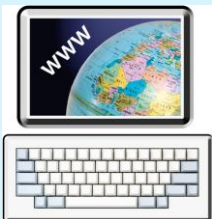
